UPON MOTION, dated the 4th day of November, 1996, on behalf of the Plaintiff, for the following Orders:

- 1. Pursuant to Rule 1008 that funds paid into Court by the Marshal or by others in accordance with the Order of Mr. Justice Joyal of June 24, 1996, be paid out to the Plaintiff after satisfaction of the fees and disbursements of the Marshal;
- 2. Pursuant to Rule 344 that the Plaintiff be entitled to recover the costs of defending the vessel and the costs of sale and the Court pursuant to Rule 344(4) award a lump sum in lieu of taxed costs.

### **REASONS:**

I have not been persuaded that the usual priorities should be altered. There is no obvious injustice to the plaintiff in retaining that order. The wages owing to the seamen take precedence over the other liens. Messrs. Peck and Smith were working as seamen during the time to which their claims relate, see *Balodis v. The Ship "Prince George"*, [1985] 1 F.C. 890 (F.C.T.D.).

Mr. Bromley is asked to prepare a draft order, approved as to form by the other parties, and including priority payment to the plaintiff on a party/party basis for the costs of the motion for sale. I would ask that the draft order be submitted to the Court by Wednesday, July 30/97.
